Chapter 1

The Why, Where, What and How of the "Simply the Word" in short STW **Workshop**

In Workshop 1 you will learn about the why, where, what and how of Bible Storying. (this material is taken from "Simply The Story" by Dorothy Miller and the ONE STORY project of SIL, and other Orality programs adapted by Marianne Chiong, SIL, Philippines.

The goal of the development of this material is

- 1. to develop a simple and effective method of memorizing and internalizing Bible stories for every age group, social group and language group.
- 2. to develop a simple cross-culturally applicable method of leading people to discover spiritual truths in the passage.
- 3. To guide the participants into hearing what God is speaking to them personally through the passage and help them to apply it through prayer and active outreach by sharing it with others.

Why do we do Bible Storying? 1

First of all God wrote the Bible as

- 10% exposition, 15% poetry and 75% narrative (story)
- How did Jesus teach?

Out of the 183 times Jesus was asked a question, Only 3 times He responded with a direct answer! All of the other times Jesus responded by asking a question or telling a story or parable. Usually, after the story, He asked a question and invited discussion.

2. Where can we use Bible Storying?

- For Personal spiritual growth
- For the Family's & children's spiritual growth
- For Witnessing
- For the spiritual growth of the Church members
- For Evangelism
- For Discipleship
- For leadership training
- For Youth meetings and any other topical teaching

3. What is the effect of Bible Storying?

- Personal deeper Bible knowledge
- Personal practical application
- People get personally involved,
- They have greater motivation to listen,
- They are challenged to pass on what they have learned ٠

- Practical application in their own lives.
- Summary:

Bible Storying is for all ages, all educational levels, all languages,

it will last without a Bible, and will speed up church planting and church growth.

- 4. How are we going to do Bible Storying Training (there are just 4 simple steps in this lesson)
 - 1. **Memorize** and internalize the story
 - 2. Find the spiritual treasures in the story
 - 3. **Apply** the spiritual treasures in your life by asking yourself what is God teaching me through this story.
 - 4. Then Share the message with others.

Chapter 2

Preparation of the Training Team: The focus of this exercise is to learn how to:

- Part 1) Memorize and internalize a Bible story
- Part 2) How to ask questions to lead the group to discovering the spiritual treasures
- **Part 3)** How to guide them to practical application with the help of the Holy Spirit and prayer.
- Part 4) How to make an Action Plan of how to share storying in a practical way

Part 1: Memorizing and internalizing the story (visualizing story) (30 min.)

- 1. Tell story: Group Listens and Visualizes each part of the story
- 2. Tell story: Group Looks at hand signs and listens to the story again
- 3. Tell story one sentence at a time,

let group repeat new sentence, then they repeat all the sentences from the beginning just watching the leader's hand signals.

- 1. Add another sentence, let group repeat new sentence,
- 2. then repeat story from the beginning.
- 3. Leader only gives hand signals while group is repeating story from the beginning.
- ⁴ Sentence 1, **2**. Repeat from the beginning
 - Sentence 1, 2, 3, Repeat from the beginning

Sentence 1, 2, 3, 4 Repeat from the beginning etc. until the entire story is memorized. No need to memorize exactly word for word but exactly picture by picture and correct message. **Guideline:** do not add or take away from the message and the meaning of the story.

4. Tell story to each other 2 by 2.

If participants need more repetition let them change partners as many times as you feel is necessary.

5. Divide into small groups of 5-7

divide groups according to language groups, age groups and or social groups.

- > 1 Group leader and 1 assistant will join the group and guide them.
- if more memorization is needed divide the group into smaller groups of only 3 or 4 people and let each one repeat the story again until they are **confident** in sharing it.

Multi-languages: If participants have memorized the story in a second language like a trade language, let them retell the story 2-3 times in their own language until they are comfortable. To help remember, they can record the story several times until it sounds natural to them. Then later on they can write it down to keep a record.

Important: The main focus of storying is to have a natural sounding, consistent, faithful to scripture message not a literal repetition of the written Scriptures, because the written form is different from the spoken form. In order to be faithful to the original Biblical message it is important that the facilitator does a good Biblical background study before crafting the story. More about story crafting and background study in later workshops.

Part 2: Questions to Search for Spiritual Treasures (30-45 min)

1. What did you learn about the people?

- Who are the people
- What are their characters
- What are their feelings
- What are their believes
- > What are their choices (what did they do, what could they have done)

2. What did you learn about Jesus / God / the Holy Spirit

- His character
- > how did he deal with the situation, how did he respond
- How else could He have responded?

Part 3: Questions for Spiritual Application

- A) Write in a notebook (10 min)
 - What is God teaching you personally through this story
 - What does God want to change in your life. Find a scripture verse as a promise or guide
- B) Share in the small group 2 minutes each (15 min)
- C) Pray for each other 2x2 or 3x3 the things you want God to change in your life (15 min)
 - give time for conviction and confession of sins
 - encourage to pray positive prayers based on the Word.

Part 4: Action Plan how to share the stories with others

1. Group assignment for the participants

Each group will develop an action plan for their church, or ministry Preparation time 1-2 hours , presentation 20 min each group

- 2. Topics:
 - What is your Goal
 - What is your Strategy
 - Who are the people who will train and who will be trained
 - What will be the budget
- 3. Home assignment after the workshop
 - Tell the story to as many people as possible to gain confidence and improve story telling ability.
 - Each trainee will **lead** the entire Bible study from the beginning memorizing, observation to application in as many sessions as possible. This can be done in the church, outreach, in the family informally with friends etc.

Part 5: Reenforcement of the Stories.

This can be done in the afternoon or evening during the workshop

- 1. Songwriting about the story
- 2. Dramatization of the story
- 3. Drawing pictures
- 4. Pantomime
- 5. Poem
- 6. Video viewing if available

Introduction

Sample of Crafted Story: Jesus Visits Martha and Mary Luke 10:38-42

Introduction:

Jesus and his disciples had been teaching all over the country side. Now they were on their way back to Jerusalem.

This is the beginning of our story.

- 38 Jesus and his disciples continued on their way toward Jerusalem.They came to a village where they met a woman by the name of Martha. Martha welcomed them into her home.
- 39 Martha had a sister by the name of Mary. Now, while Jesus was teaching, Mary sat down at his feet and listened to him.
- 40 In the meantime, Martha was all worried and upset over the <u>big dinner</u> she was preparing.
 So she came to Jesus and said, "Lord, don't you care that my sister is just sitting here while I am doing all the work. Tell her to come and help me!"
- 41 But Jesus looked at her and said: "Martha, Martha! You are worried and troubled over <u>so many things</u>,
- 42 but there is only <u>one thing worth being concerned about</u>.Mary has chosen the right thing, and I will not take it away from her."
